# INTERNATIONAL VAURIEN CLASS BUOYANCY CHECK LOGBOOK 2011

*For a boat to be eligible for Racing, its hull certificate shall carry a satisfactory buoyancy check confirmation. Wherever the certificate doesn't have a suitable space for such confirmation, this form shall be used and presented in conjunction with the certificate at an event.*

*The buoyancy check certificate may be issued by a measurer or by the club of membership or even by the own sailor in cases where there are no such organizations.*

Extract from Vaurien Class Rules:

### «C.6.2 BUOYANCY

*The owner is responsible at all times for the buoyancy and for ensuring that at intervals of not more than 12 months the buoyancy is tested according to Appendix H and declaration endorsed by an equipment inspector. If in doubt regarding compliance with B.2.1 an equipment inspector may order a buoyancy test, afterwards checking the buoyancy tanks for significant leakage. If the buoyancy is deemed unsatisfactory, the certificate shall be withdrawn and not return until satisfactory remedial measures have been taken.»*
